May 1 – Junior and Senior Prom

The Grand March begins at 7PM and will be held at the entrance of the high school. We are requesting only parents attend and that they wear masks and practice social distancing. The Grand March and the announcement of King and Queen will be streamed on Facebook. The dance will be held from 8-11PM in the high school gym so that dancing can be spread out in a large area. Activities will be going on concurrently in other areas in order to keep the number of students from being too large in one area. Additional activities will include a photo booth, corn hole tournament, special concessions, and possibly a movie.

May 14 – Middle School Awards Assembly

Students will gather in the BHS gymnasium to receive a variety of academic awards. Live streaming will be available. The program will begin at 1:00PM in the high school gymnasium.

May 18 – Graduation Practice and Bell Ringing Ceremony

Graduation practice will be held on Tuesday, May 18th at 8AM. Seniors who plan on participating in the commencement ceremony must attend practice on this day. Commencement practice will begin at 8:15AM promptly! Students that are not on time and dressed appropriately will not take part.

- Meet in the Middle School gymnasium
- Bring your cap and gown
- Everyone must be present to avoid confusion.
- Students who do not attend the rehearsal will not be permitted to participate in the commencement ceremony.
- We will be taking a panoramic class picture, individual graduation photos, Wall of Fame, and group photos for the yearbook after practice ends.
 - We ask that you wear semi-formal attire.
 - Please look neat and well groomed.
 - Wear flat shoes rather than heels that may sink in the ground.

Starting at 8:00AM we will take individual graduation photos and a group photo that students will be given in 8x10 format. We will then walk through the processional, recessional and ceremony with all seniors.



Immediately following practice, seniors will board buses to Bucyrus Elementary School for the Bell Ringing Ceremony, which we hope to begin at 9:30AM. Like prom, we are restricting the audience to parents only. Live streaming will be available for others to view. We will have a photographer in attendance to purchase photos from after the event.

May 20 – Senior Awards and Baccalaureate

Seniors selected to receive scholarships should arrive no later than 6:15PM and report to the Little Theater. The Awards ceremony will begin at 6:30PM in the high school gymnasium. Parents are welcomed to attend. Live streaming will be available. All seniors are encouraged to attend the Baccalaureate service, which is expected to begin at 7:30PM in the gymnasium.

May 21 – 152nd Commencement Exercise at Bucyrus Stadium @ 8:00PM

Note the start time has been changed to 8PM in an attempt to accommodate seniors who may be competing in sports tournaments. Seniors will receive detailed instructions at the start of May in their email and in the school day.
