<b>Ohio COVID-19 Risk Level Guidelines for the Public</b>			
<b>LEVEL 1</b>	<b>LEVEL 2</b>	<b>LEVEL 3</b>	<b>LEVEL 4</b>
<b>PUBLIC EMERGENCY</b> Active exposure and spread. Follow all current health orders.	<b>PUBLIC EMERGENCY</b> Increased exposure and spread. Exercise high degree of caution. Follow all current health orders.	<b>PUBLIC EMERGENCY</b> Very high exposure and spread. Limit activities as much as possible. Follow all current health orders.	<b>PUBLIC EMERGENCY</b> Severe exposure and spread. Only leave home for supplies and services. Follow all current health orders.
<b>Bucyrus' Education Format Guidelines</b>

<p><b>PREK:</b> Half-day sessions</p> <p><b>Grades K - 12:</b> Students attend school all day, every day Bus services provided. Face coverings mandatory for all riders. Two students per seat Staggered arrival and dismissal times determined by building administration Parents assess student health before school</p> <p>Social distance observed (3ft. - 6ft.)</p> <p>Frequent hand sanitizing and additional cleaning of surfaces No visitors or volunteers</p> <p>Lunchroom spaces expanded to other areas</p> <p>No field trips or large gatherings of students</p> <p>No shared student supplies</p> <p>Breakfast grab and go or in classrooms</p>		<p>Same as Level 1 and 2. However, upon designation of a Level 3 or Level 4 risk level, Bucyrus City Schools may confer with Crawford County Public Health to determine if the indicators that caused the increase in risk level impact the school district and if there is need to change the educational format to hybrid or remote.</p>	
<b>Staff and students are required to wear approved face coverings.</b>			
<i>Education format is subject to change based on state, regional and/or local factors related to the pandemic.</i>			

<b>HYBRID LEARNING MODEL</b>
<p><b>PREK:</b> Half-day sessions</p> <p><b>Grades K - 5:</b> AM/PM Schedule: 50% of students in the AM and the other 50% in the PM. Breakfast and take home lunch provided for AM students; lunch and take home breakfast provided for PM students.</p> <p><b>Grades 6 - 12:</b> Monday and Thursday: Students with last names beginning A thru L attend in-class while M thru Z attend virtually. Tuesday and Friday: Students with last names M thru Z attend in-class while A thru L attend virtually. Wednesday: Teacher office hours, enrichment and remediation, TBT, BLT, DLT meetings, and additional disinfecting.</p>

<b>REMOTE LEARNING MODEL</b>
<p>Attendance taken dialy via Google or Zoom classroom</p> <p>Breakfast and lunch provided grab and go</p> <p>Adjusted special education services per the Individual Education Plan</p> <p>All other provisions from Levels 1 and 2</p>
