



New health and safety guidelines to go into effect Thursday, September 2, 2021:

1. Masks will be required to be worn by all employees, students, parents, and visitors in all Bucyrus City Schools buildings (including inside athletic facilities).
2. Social distancing of a minimum of 3 ft. will continue to be enforced in all areas that can handle the spacing.
3. Hand sanitizing will continue as currently prescribed.
4. Contact tracing will be conducted by the administration, school nurses, and Crawford County Public Health.
5. Those identified as close contacts will be contacted by a school administrator and/or school nurse.
6. Close contact may be required to quarantine for 10 days (see CCHP Document on website).
7. Quarantined students will receive classroom assignments via computer or learning packets.
8. Visitors will be restricted during school hours to parents visiting the office or clinic.
9. Masks will continue to be worn on buses. Social distancing will be enforced on the buses.
